TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all junior & adult USBC Members in good standing, who have registered & paid the entry fee. Eligible participants who are not USBC members can qualify, prior to participation, by paying a participation fee. (The fee is \$5.00 for adults; \$2.00 for youth.) A bowler may bowl with more than one person as long as they pay the entry fee, minus lineage. Their 3 game total will be used for each person they bowl with.

DIVISIONS: This is a handicap tournament with an optional scratch division. Divisions (boys & girls): 300 & lower, 301 & higher. Divisions may be combined if there aren't enough bowlers in one division (5). Bowlers will use their final book average for the 2008-2009 season. If you don't have a 2008-2009 book average, you must use your current highest average, minimum of 9 games. If no average is available, you must use a 220 average to participate. Handicap is based on 90% of 220.

VERIFICATION: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event. If you are using your current average, average verification must accompany the entry form.

Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBCA Youth. All protests & appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329.

Substitutes will be allowed, if necessary, & must report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

NO entry fee will be returned! Returned checks (including bank fees) must be made good with cash or a bank check.

BOWLERS' AREA: Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. Please, **NO** cell phones or electronic devices in the settee area.

LANGUAGE: The use of profanity by any participant will result in Disqualification. The tournament director's decision is **FINAL**.

DRESS CODE: Shirts with name & city/state are encouraged. You are encouraged to wear slacks & a collared shirt. Attire must be neat, clean & proper fitting (no undergarments showing.) No attire advertising liquor, tobacco products or inappropriate language. No shorts or hats. The tournament director's decision is final.

SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS: Scholarships will be given to the youth bowlers. Scholarships will be awarded at a 1 to 5 ratio. All monies collected for scholarships will be returned 100%. A minimum \$25 scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy, not to exceed \$30 in value, in place of the scholarship. Certificates & gift cards will be awarded to the adults at a 1 to 5 ratio.

Anything not covered in these rules will be governed by the USBC rule/play book.
