TOURNAMENT RULES

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all junior & adult USBC Members in good standing, who have registered & paid the entry fee. Eligible participants who are not USBC members can qualify, prior to participation, by paying a participation fee. (The fee is \$5.00 for adults; \$2.00 for youth.)

AVERAGE & HANDICAP: Handicap will be 90% of 220. Bowlers will use their high book average for the 2008-2009 season. If no book average, the bowler will use their current average, 21 games or more, as of March 14, 2010. If average as of March 14, 2010 is ten pins or higher than last year's book average then you must use that average (minimum 21 games). All others bowl scratch.

VERIFICATION: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event. If you are using a current average, verification must accompany the entry form or be in the tournament director's possession before the start of the tournament.

DIVISIONS: The average divisions are as follows (minimum of 5 bowlers per division; divisions may be combined.)

9 Games Only: Scratch Youth or Scratch Adult

7 Games Only: Scratch Youth or Scratch Adult

Handicap Youth or Handicap Adult

150 & lower; 151-170; 171 & higher

5 Games Only: Handicap Youth or Handicap Adult

150 & lower; 151 & higher

Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBCA Youth. All protests & appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329.

NO entry fee will be returned! Returned checks (including bank fees) must be made good with cash or a bank check

BOWLERS' AREA: Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. Please, **NO** cell phones or electronic devices in the settee area.

LANGUAGE: The use of profanity by any participant will result in Disqualification. The tournament director's decision is FINAL.

DRESS CODE: Shirts with name & city/state are encouraged. You are encouraged to wear slacks & a collared shirt. Attire must be neat, clean & proper fitting (no undergarments showing.) No attire advertising liquor, tobacco products or inappropriate language. No shorts or hats. The tournament director's decision is FINAL.

SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS: Scholarships will be given to the youth bowlers. Scholarships will be awarded at a 1 to 5 ratio. All monies collected for scholarships will be returned 100%. A minimum \$25 scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy, not to exceed \$30 in value, in place of the scholarship. Certificates & gift cards will be awarded to the adults at a 1 to 5 ratio.

Anything not covered in these rules will be governed by the USBC rule/play book.
