TOURNAMENT RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY: Open to all junior & adult bowlers who are members of the USBC & are in good standing. Eligible participants who **are not** USBC members can qualify, prior to participation, by paying a participation fee, which will be put into the scholarship fund. (The fee is: \$5.00 for adults; \$2.00 for youth)

2. DIVISIONS: Bowlers will use their current highest league average, minimum 9 games, as of April 20, 2008. Average verification **must** accompany the entry form or be in the tournament director's possession before the start of the tournament. If you do not have a current average, you must use a 220 average to participate. Handicap is based on 90% of 220. The average divisions are as follows (**minimum of 7 bowlers per division; divisions may be combined**):
 - 10 Games Only: Scratch Youth or Scratch Adult
 - 7 Games Only: Handicap Youth or Handicap Adult
150 & lower; 151-170; 171-190
 - 4 Games Only: Handicap Youth or Handicap Adult
90 & lower; 91-110; 111-130

*4 game bowlers will bowl all 4 games on the same set of lanes; 7 game & 10 game bowlers will move after each game.

3. VERIFICATION: It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify bowler if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Correction to averages must be made before the end of the first game.

4. All disagreements will be handled through the Tournament Committee of the NUUSBCA Youth. The decision of the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.

5. NO entry fee will be returned!! There will be a \$30.00 return check charge.

6. BOWLER'S AREA: Only bowlers & tournament officials shall be permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. NO cell phones or electronic devices in the bowler's area, except official electronic scoring devices.

7. LANGUAGE: The use of profanity by any bowler or spectator will **not be** tolerated. **Disqualification** will be the consequence. Tournament Officials decisions are FINAL!!

8. DRESS CODE: Slacks & shirts with name & city/state are encouraged. Attire must be neat, clean & proper fitting (no undergarments showing). NO shorts, hats or attire advertising liquor, tobacco products or inappropriate language. Tournament Officials decisions are FINAL.

9. SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS: Scholarships will be given to the youth bowlers. Scholarships will be awarded at a 1 to 7 ratio. All monies collected for scholarships will be returned 100%. There will be the option of a trophy/plaque, not to exceed \$25 in value, in place of a scholarship. Awards will be given to the adult bowlers at a 1 to 5 ratio.

ANYTHING NOT COVERED IN THESE RULES WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE 2007-2008 USBC RULE/PLAY BOOK.
